Amendments that came into force on 24 May 2025 at the General Assembly

Art 13 By-Laws: substantive amendment converning the benefits payable to rightful claimants in the event of death.

<u>Purpose of the amendment</u>: to put minor children and adult children on an equal footing.

Examples of the application by default or upon request of the new Art. 13, para.1 a of the By-Laws
